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The 2IBB ITMS degree is open to any Active/Guard/Reserve Air Force personnel or Other Service Instructor (OSI) that instructs a CCAF degree-applicable course at a CCAF-Affiliated school.



ITMS Degree Requirements



Special requirements for the ITMS degree:

- Completed their career-field related degree Exception: (Other Service Instructors and Enlisted PME Instructors (8T000)
- > 3 SH of approved Instructor Methodology
- > 12 SH of Teaching Internship
- All other degree requirements must be completed within two years of registration into the 2IBB degree program

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Subsequent Degrees for OSI



- Other Service Instructors (OSI) are allowed to receive a CCAF Associates degree in the career field they instruct in.
- Example: A Navy firefighter instructs the Fire Protection Apprentice course at Goodfellow AFB, the OSI is eligible to receive an ITMS degree and a Fire Science degree.
- OSIs are authorized to switch degree programs prior to receiving the ITMS degree. This can be approved if they will be able to receive a CCAF Associates degree quicker.
- ✓ Example: BIC + Teaching Internship = 20 SH

Fire Protection + JST + DoD Fire Certs = 24 up to 39 SH



Subsequent Degrees for OSI



- Requirements in STARS and STARS-FD must be met prior to switching degree programs:
 - 3 SH of approved Instructor Methodology must be loaded to the record
 - The Date Assigned Instructor Duty (DAID) must be entered into STARS-FD
 - The "Assigned" tab must show what CCAF-Affiliated course is being taught
 - All civilian college/university transcripts, Joint Service Transcripts (JST), DoD certificates, CCAF-Affiliated and ACE accredited course completion certificates must be sent to CCAF for evaluation.

Instructor Methodology courses and Teaching Internship will reflect in bold on the "Attended" tab. Ensure "Meth" and "Intern" both reflect [Y]. This information must be present for the instructor to graduate.



- If an OSI is given a "Removed Date" in STARS-FD, they are immediately no longer eligible for the ITMS or career-field related degree. All degree requirements must be completed by the OSI prior to being removed from the instructor podium.
- An OSI could still receive a CCAF degree if they met all degree requirements prior to being removed from the podium. They must immediately visit their local Air Force education office for further guidance.
